The Southern California Genealogical Society has held Genealogy Jamboree for 51 years and a Genetic Genealogy Conference for 9. Nationally known speakers covered the latest developments in genealogy from across the US, Canada, Mexico and the world.

This year the Genealogy Jamboree and Genetic Genealogy Conference will be 100% virtual and streamed on-line again—from August 19–27, 2022. All all programs and presentations will be available to Jamboree and Genealogy Conference registrants through the end of October.

Genetic Genealogy Conference (August 19-20) will feature over 20 renowned genetic genealogy experts, sponsored talks and live Q&A. Presenters include Diahan Southard, David Dowell, Judy G. Russell, Richard Hill and Kitty Munson Cooper. Author Jonny Perl's keynote program is "*The Need for Third-party DNA Tools*."

JamboFree (August 22-24) is free to everyone, not just attendees. It will include ethnic and DNA round tables where individuals can seek advice from experts, 15+ classes and programs plus Jambo Expo, a virtual exhibit hall.

Genealogy Jamboree (August 26-27) will have 47 speakers, sponsored talks and live Q & A. Speakers include Michael Brophy, Nicka Sewell Smith, Peggy Clemens Lauritzen, Michael Strauss and Bill Cole. The Keynote talk "*Preserving Your Family Tales: What's in a Name?*" will be by Bernice Alexander Bennett.

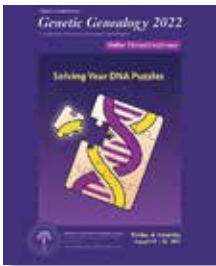

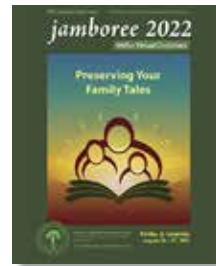

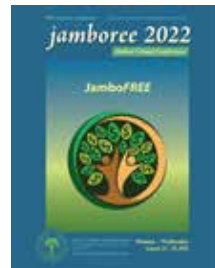

- #1 **The Genetic Genealogy Conference kicks off our series.** Attendees will have a choice between Standard or Plus Registration with Standard Registration.
